

PART ONE:

You receive from Crochet Design:-

A binder containing your signed agreement.

Notes on completing the course.

A list of compulsory samples plus a selection of projects from which to make your choice.

The binder also contains information on:

Tunisian crochet

Broomstick crochet

Hairpin crochet

Buttons and braids

Filet and thread crochet

(*You are guided as to how to produce a portfolio or alternative means of arranging your course work.)

Four bi-monthly newsletters-once you have enrolled – plus a reference book. *These have been found to be very useful and a source of student exchange. Consequently, when the fourth newsletter is received, there is an option to continue taking them.

Overseas students: a video of how to put the course material together is included and this is a purchase option for British students.

A record of work

A very brief area of study

A multi-choice question paper

*It is never necessary to repeat the way work has been recorded or to do another area of study as, for these two items; there is no minimum pass in Part One. They must, however, be submitted.

Once the necessary high standard in all areas has been obtained, a certificate is issued indicating that you have successfully completed Part One of the International Diploma in Crochet – Basic Techniques.
