

PART THREE:

The binder for Part Three contains:

- a signed agreement
- notes on completing the course
- a list of compulsory samples which should depict your chosen theme

The selection of projects is worked from an inspirational source which can be different for each project and yet still complementing the chosen theme.

Including crochet as part of a mixed media project continues the learning of new skills. *See the illustrations here, examples of work submitted by previous students and indicating just some of the variety in size and inspirational source.

Four bi-monthly newsletters are included in the cost of Part Three.

*You are encouraged to send in your idea for each submission prior to commencing the practical work. The area of in depth study covers 50% of the assessment marks. A supervised examination paper is followed by an oral examination for which there is a fee. An optional scheme is available for those wishing to continue only with the practical aspects of crochet – and not proceed with an in-depth study.

On obtaining the necessary high standard in all areas a full certificate is issued indicating that you have successfully completed Part Three of the International Diploma in Crochet – “Mixed Media”. If you have chosen to successfully complete Scheme B, a letter of achievement to that effect will be issued.

When all three certificates have been obtained, the student graduates with the Diploma showing the specialism taken.

On completion, heartfelt congratulations should be expected from family, friends and colleague crochet crafters.
