\*You are encouraged to send in a record of work on each submission. The area of study will be assessed and is usually an introduction to the in depth study you plan to do in Part Two. A practical examination paper will be undertaken in your own time but the written question paper will be completed under supervision. A small fee should be included when requesting the examination papers/\*Scheme B is available for those wishing to continue only with the practical aspects of crochet – and not study design and pattern writing.

On obtaining the necessary high standard in all areas a full certificate is issued indicating that you have successfully completed Part Two of the International Diploma in Crochet – “Expanding Crochet Skills”. If you have chosen to successfully complete Scheme B, a letter of achievement to that effect will be issued.
