

PART TWO: As with Part One, you receive from Crochet Design:-

1. A BINDER

The binder contains your signed agreement

A list of compulsory samples and six projects showcasing your crochet design ideas and ability to communicate these ideas. The projects should be chosen to suit your needs whilst fulfilling the requirements of the course.

Notes on writing your study research. The area of study will be assessed and is usually an introduction to the in depth study you plan to do in Part Two.

Presenting a portfolio to commerce

Mock question papers both written and practical

Application forms for taking the written examination in your own area. The fee should be included when requesting the examination papers

(Note: there is a Scheme B available for those wishing to continue only with the practical aspects of crochet – and not study design and pattern writing).

Record sheet of your assessments.

2. HISTORY of crochet in book(let) form

3. Four BI-MONTHLY NEWSLETTERS once you have enrolled, with the option to continue taking them should you not have completed Part II before they end

4. NO LIMIT to how many times a piece can be submitted for assessment. Should the submission be below the 80% pass, you are given reasons why it needs resubmitting and when necessary additional information sheets will be sent to assist you.

5. A CERTIFICATE showing that you have succeeded in obtaining the necessary high standard in all areas is issued depicting you have completed Part Two of the International Diploma in Crochet – “Expanding Crochet Skills”. If you have chosen to successfully complete Scheme B, a letter of achievement to that effect will be issued
